# Unencrypted communication to Active Directory services

## BIZERBA-SA-2025-0006

### 1. Summary

When using domain users as BRAIN2 users, communication with Active Directory services is unencrypted. This can lead to the interception of authentication data and compromise confidentiality.

### 2. Affected Products

BRAIN2 Version <3.07

### 3. Mitigation

Do not use domain users as BRAIN2 users in unprotected networks. Use local BRAIN2 users instead.

### 4. Solution

Update to version 3.07

### 5. Technical Details

In addition to the unencrypted LDAP protocol, starting with version 3.07, the encrypted LDAPS protocol can be used to communicate with Active Directory services.

### 6. CVSS Rating

The CVSS Base Score is rated at: 8.4 (High)
